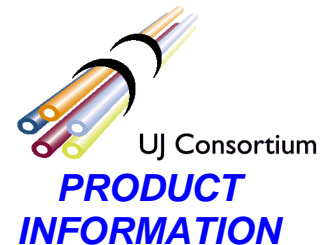

CLARIFICATION ON THE USE OF CUTTING LINES

The UJ Consortium would like to clarify the use of cutting lines used during UJ & UQJ joint preparation.

Nylon mono-filament line or fishing line (LNE001PP) must be used in applications where the area is subsequently moulded. (ref UJCM034 & UJCM062). This type of line ensures a clean cut with no residual strands of nylon which could remain within the moulding as an inclusion. Mono-filament line can be stranded if required by twisting two or more lengths together.

Stranded Nylon Line (LNE002PP) can be used for cutting where the area will not be moulded, such as armour serving and screen preparation. It can also be used as a wrapping aid during ferrule preparation. **It must never be used for cutting polyethylene in areas which will be moulded.**
