UJ & UQJ JOINTER CERTIFICATES DURING THE CURRENT COVID-19 VIRUS PANDEMIC

Due to extenuating circumstances of the Covid-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic and the difficulty of travel and interaction at this time, it has been decided to extend valid qualified jointers' certificates that expire within the period 1st April to 30th June 2020 by an extra 90 days (3 months) past their current expiry date. Valid certificates, expiring between 1st March and 31st March, can be extended until 30th June.

During this extension period the situation will be monitored and prior to 30th June, further communication will be made by the UJ Consortium.
