UJ & UQJ JOINTER CERTIFICATES DURING THE CURRENT COVID-19 VIRUS PANDEMIC

Due to the continued extenuating circumstances of the Covid-19 (Coronavirus) pandemic and the difficulty of travel and interaction at this time, it has been decided to further extend valid qualified jointers' certificates that expire within the period 1st March to 30th September 2020 until 30th June 2021. The expiry dates of Jointer Qualification Certificates, currently due to expire between 1st October 2020 and 31st March 2021 inclusive, will now be extended by 270 days (9 months).

During this extension period the situation will be monitored and prior to 31st March 2021, further communication will be made by the UJ Consortium. Jointers are recommended to carry out retraining and requalification if practical, safe and available.
